PARENTAL STANDARDS AGREEMENT

- 1. Act with respect and integrity when in the club setting.
- 2. Follow the instructions of the instructor(s) and/or other team members to help classes run safely and smoothly.
- 3. Ensure that your child is fit and ready to take part in classes.
- 4. Ensure your child attends the class wearing their dobok, with belt and a bottle of water. (T-shirt can be worn instead of dobok top)
- 5. Drop off and pick up our child in good time and as agreed. Drop offs and pick ups should be from the door of the training hall. (Any variation to this must be agreed in writing by the Instructor at least 24 hrs prior to any class). (Parents are of course welcome to stay and spectate their child training)
- 6. Payment for each class attended to be made via BACS transfer prior to class start time
- 7. Respond to digital communications where appropriate from the club, including correspondence on club membership and any relevant medical declarations.
- 8. Keep the club updated if any medical conditions, medication or injuries should become relevant.
- 9. Update the club immediately if any unrecorded/undisclosed injuries have occurred during a class.
- 10. Keep the club updated immediately with any changes to contact details/emergency contact details.

- 12. Do all we can to keep all club members safe.
